

CIRCULAR

Subject:- Usage of C.R.M.B-55 in Road works- reg.,

It has come to the notice of the undersigned that the C.R.M.B is not being used in some of the road projects, where it was contemplated to use C.R.M.B in the sanctioned estimates as per the guidelines of IRC & MOSRT&H, citing the reason that sufficient quantity of the material is not available at the refineries. The Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., and the Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd., have informed the Government that adequate quantity of C.R.M.B-55 is available in their refineries. Hence, in view of its extended durability and adequate availability of the C.R.M.B, it is once again reiterated and directed to make use of this material procuring from the refineries and ensure quality roads by using C.R.M.B without fail.
