CIRCULAR

Sub:-Preparedness for the Ensuing Monsoon of 2006.

The 2006 Monsoon has already commenced. It is the experience of previous years that many natural calamities have taken place which has caused damages to Roads, Buildings, C.D.works and also public life. It is the primary responsibility and duty of the department to protect the assets of the Government and protect them against any eventualities. The department should be prepared to face any eventualities, which may happen during monsoon period.

The officers of the department shall invariably inspect all the structures under their control at all vulnerable places and see that they are kept intact. Periodical inspection shall be done about the fitness of the structures and if found unsafe, the same shall be brought to safe condition immediately before the monsoon. All men and materials shall be kept ready to take-up immediate relief works.


In case any damages occur, the concerned Engineers should immediately inspect the spot and inform the D.Cs concerned and other higher authorities about the magnitude of damages caused telegraphically. A realistic estimate for restoration of work shall be prepared and sent to concerned D.Cs and obtain their approval and the restoration works should be taken up duly obtaining the approval from district administration.

All the officers / officials are directed not to leave the Headquarters during the monsoon. However in case of inevitable circumstances, prior approval of the

competent authority shall be taken before leaving the Headquarters. Persons in charge of the structures shall always be vigilant

This should be followed scrupulously and any lapses in this regard will be viewed seriously.
