Sub:-Constitution of Review Committee to review the progress of the work and the reports submitted by the Consultants for the Karnataka State Highway Improvement Project-2 Project.

PREAMBLE:-

After the successful implementation of the Karnataka State Highways Improvement Project Phase (KSHIP-1), the Government has now decided to undertake Phase-2 of KSHIP with a view to bring about improvement to many more State Highways in the State. In the G.O. dated 14-8-2006 cited at read (1), an Evaluation Committee was constituted to assess the Requests for Proposal received for appointment of PCC Consultants to be engaged for preparation of the Detailed Project Report (DPR), Bid Documents, safeguard instruments and implementation support for the KSHIP-2 Project. Based on the recommendations of the Evaluation Committee and with the approval of the World Bank, the PCC Consultancy Services was entrusted to M/s Scott Wilson Kirkpatrick Plc, UK in joint venture with M/s Scott Wilson Kirkpatrick India Pvt. Ltd. and the agreement was signed with them on 25-1-2007. In the meanwhile, Government, after consulting the Project Governing Board of the KSHIP, approved to take up 34 kms. of roads for improvement under the KSHIP-2 commencing in the financial year 2008-09, vide G.O. dated 25-11-2006 cited at read (2) above.

The PCC Consultants have commenced the services and submitted the inception report. They will be submitting further reports also in course of time relating to the progress of work. It is considered desirable to constitute a Review Committee to review the progress of the work and the reports submitted by the Consultants for the KSHIP-2 Project from time to time. Hence, the following order.
