

PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub:-Constitution of a Steering Group to steer the study relating to Private Sector Development & Private Sector Participation in Road Sector.

Read:-Chief Project Officer, Karnataka State Highway Improvement Project proposal dated 20-7-2005.

PREAMBLE:-

The Government of Karnataka has taken up improvements to State Highways with the assistance of World Bank loan through Karnataka State Highway Improvement Project. Under this scheme there is a provision for taking up/ improving the functioning of Public Works Department through Institutional Development Strategy (IDS). As a part of I.D.S. it is proposed to prepare a Policy frame work to facilitate Private Sector Development (PSD) and achieve stake holder involvement to bring about Private Sector Participation (PSP) in the improvement of Road Sector in Karnataka.

Accordingly the consultants M/s Infrastructure Development Corporation (Karnataka) Ltd. (iDeck) has been mobilized to render the services and to prepare the necessary frame work for P.S.D. and P.S.P


The Consultancy firm is to render the following services.

- a) analyse the status of Road Sector in P.W.D. including prioritization of projects, road network funding and road users/ stake holders, interests etc
- b) prepare frame work for prioritization of road projects and appraisal
- c) prepare frame work of tolling
- d) prepare frame work for Private Sector Development and implementation through Private Sector Participation
- e) prepare frame work for stake holder involvement

- f) prepare safety frame work &
- g) prepare frame work regulation

It is proposed that the services rendered by the Consultant shall be monitored by a Committee during the implementation of the services as per the Clause 5.1 of the agreement.
