The Karnataka State Highways Authority has been established as an advisory body as approved by the Project Governing Board of the KSHIP in its meeting held on 02-07-2001 under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary.

The Authority is currently acting as an advisory body for the highways, traffic & transport thus covering the entire transport sector. The Authority is thus covering human resource development, construction, maintenance, upgradation etc. pertaining to highways. It is covering subjects such as traffic & road safety pertaining to traffic. It is also covering subjects like overloading pertaining to the Transport Department thus truly reflecting the sectoral coverage of the Authority. To have a clear sector strategy & a sector policy framework leading in future to a possible sector investment programme, the Authority will continue to encompass the entire transport sector in its three sub-sectors of construction & maintenance of highways, traffic & road safety and transport.


To truly reflect the said sectoral coverage of the Authority it is felt necessary to rename the Authority as the "Karnataka State Highways, Traffic & Transport Authority".
